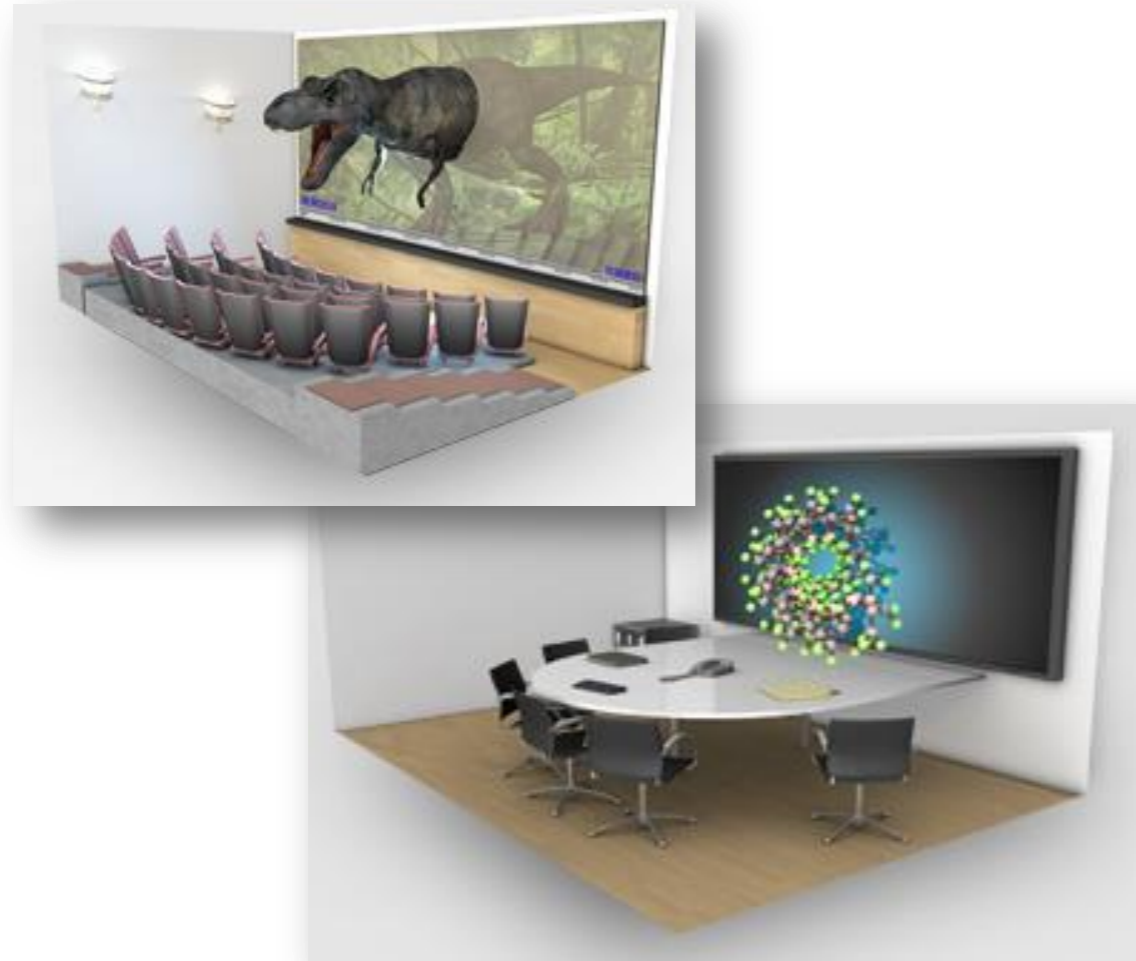

What is Active shutter 3D system?

An active shutter 3D system is a must-have tool in project-based learning, electronic prototyping and making.

- ▶ It is a technique of displaying stereoscopic 3D images.
- ▶ When the image intended for the left eye is displayed, the right eye's vision is blocked and vice versa. This process is repeated so rapidly that the interruptions do not interfere with the perceived fusion of the two images into a single 3D image.
- ▶ Modern active shutter 3D systems generally use liquid crystal shutter glasses. Each eye's glass contains a liquid crystal layer which becomes opaque when voltage is applied, or, otherwise, remains transparent.
- ▶ A timing signal allows the glasses to alternately block one eye, and then the other, in synchronization with the refresh rate of the screen. The timing synchronization to the video equipment may be achieved via a wired signal, or wirelessly by either an infrared or radio frequency transmitter.
In our case the signal will be transmitted wirelessly by the TV thanks to the 3D graphic card.

How does it work?

▶ Desktop Computer

- The desktop computer represents the structure of this 3D Experience.
- It has to be powerful enough to run CATIA.

▶ 3D Graphic Card

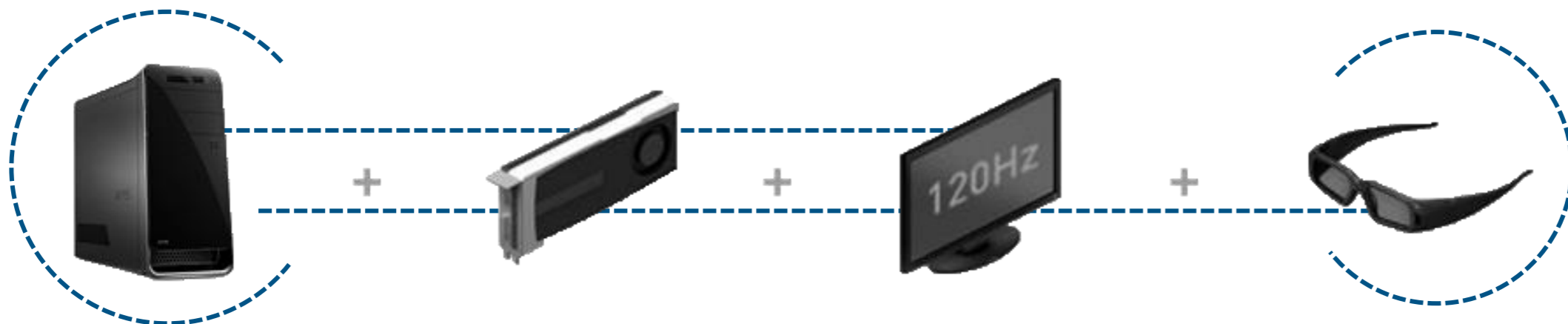
- The 3D graphic card represents the heart of this 3D Experience.
- It will replace the standard graphic card you have on your current desktop computer.

▶ 3D Screen

- Connected to the 3D graphic card, it will decode the active signal and display the images.
- At the same time, it will transmit another signal, coming from the 3D graphic card, to the 3D glasses.

▶ 3D Glasses

- The 3D glasses will use the signal coming from the graphic card to switch from the right-eye image to the left-eye image.



What is in this package?

- AMD dedicated drivers for the 3D graphic card
- Logitech dedicated drivers for the space mouse (optional)
- A 3D Model to test your configuration

How to set up the devices

▶ **Installing the drivers**

- Launch the AMD shortcut and follow the instructions (no custom installation)
- Launch the LOGITECH shortcut and follow the instructions (no custom installation)

▶ **Installing the graphic card**

- In your computer, replace the old graphic card by the new W7100 3D graphic card

▶ **Connecting the desktop computer to the screen**

- Use the 1.4 HDMI cable to connect the screen to the adaptor
- Connect the adaptor to the new graphic card you have installed in computer

How to set up the stereo

Use the following steps to set up your version of CATIA V5:

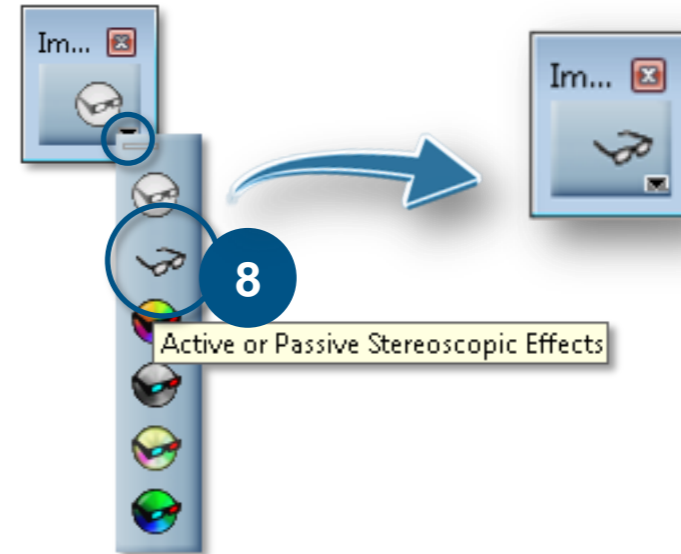
1. Click on **Tools > Options > General > Display > Visualization**
2. Click on the **Devices** tab
3. Click on **On** next to **Stereo** option to enable stereoscopic viewing
4. Click on **OK**
5. Restart your session to save your settings
6. Enter the following command: **c:Stereoscopic** in the power input field and press **Enter**
7. Set the **Stereo** option to **On** to enable stereoscopic viewing
8. To set the distance between your eyes in **Manual mode**, type it in the corresponding field.
9. Click on **OK**

How to set up the stereo

Use the following steps to set up your version of CATIA V6:



1. Click on **Tools > Options > General > Immersive Virtuality**
2. Click on the **Immersive Configuration** tab
3. Check the box to enable stereoscopic display
4. Click on **OK**
5. Restart your session to save the settings
6. Go to tab **View > Toolbars > General > Immersive Virtuality**
7. Check the box **Immersive Virtuality** to display the associate toolbar
8. Click on the little arrow to open a submenu and set up this type of 3D:

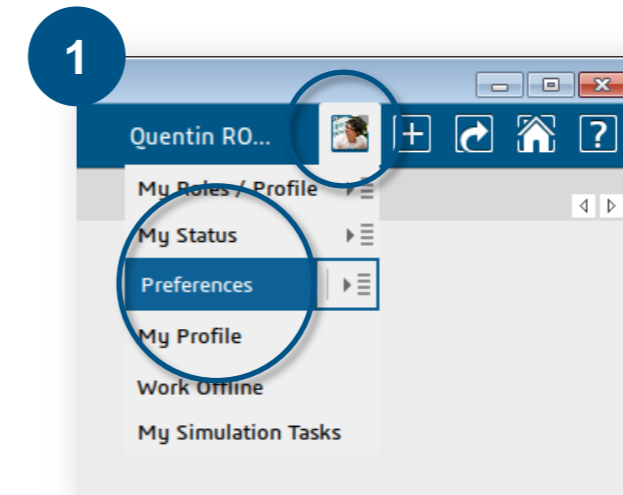

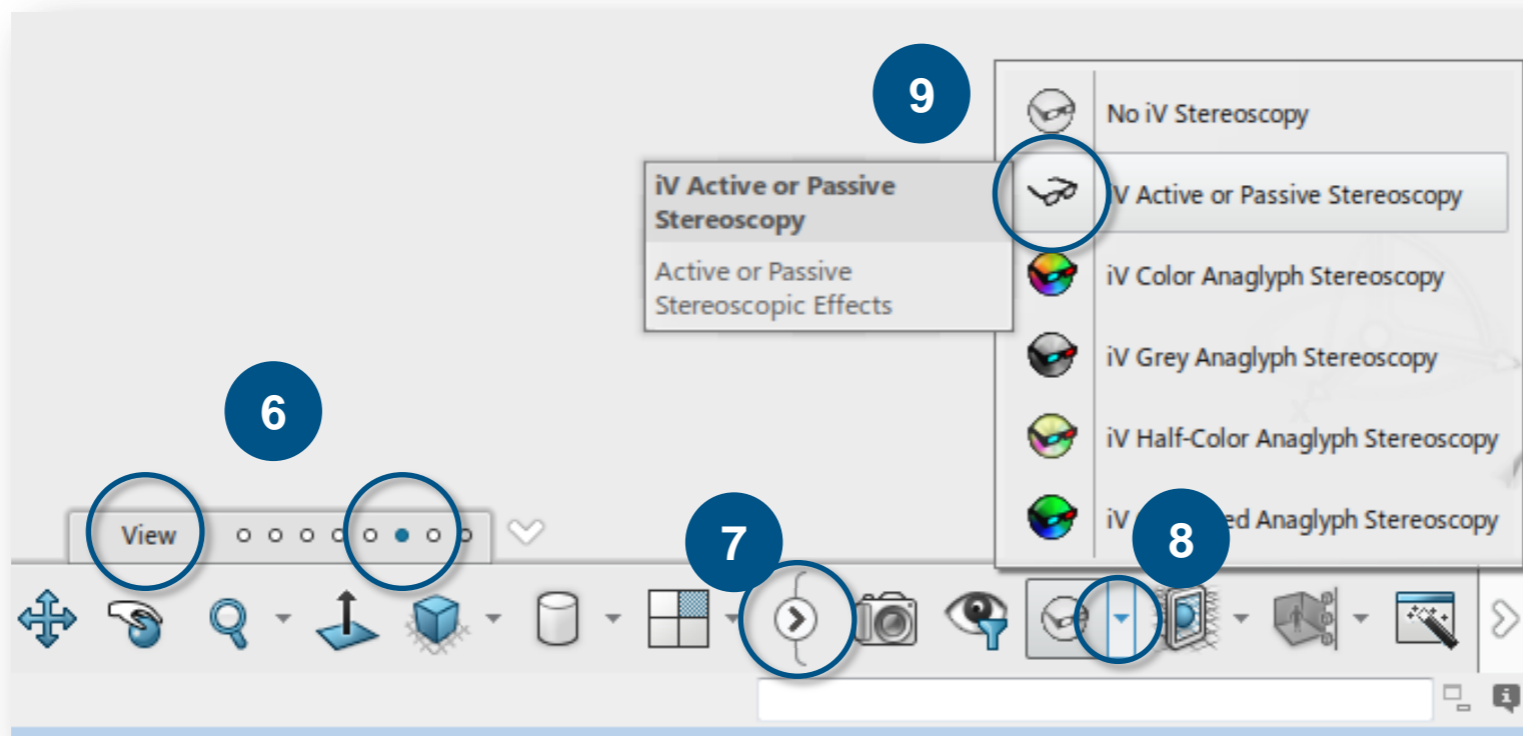
How to set up the stereo

Use the following steps to set up the **3DEXPERIENCE**:

1. Click on profile picture and select **Preferences**
2. Click on the **Immersive Configuration** tab
3. Check the box to enable stereoscopic display
4. Click on OK
5. Restart your session to save your settings
6. Go to panel called View
7. Click on this arrow  to display the submenu
8. Click on the little arrow next to this button: 
9. Set the **Active** or **Passive Stereoscopy**
